**Eligibility to be a blood donor**

- Should be enjoying good health, weighing above 41 Kg (90 lbs) and between 16 – 65 years
- Not a carrier of Hepatitis Viruses
- Have not spent 3 months or more cumulatively in the UK between 1980 to 1996; have not spent 5 years or more cumulatively in Europe countries from 1980 to present or more cumulatively in Europe countries from 1980 to present
- Blood Donation Precautionary Measures in Response to COVID-19:
- Member of the public who has traveled outside Hong Kong recently can come to donate blood after completing all quarantine measures and obtaining negative results of all testing for inbound travelers required by the HKSAR government
- Member of public who had contracted COVID-19 (confirmed positive via rapid antigen test/nucleic acid test), or had close contact with a confirmed/suspected COVID-19 case, should be deferred from blood donation for a minimum of 14 days. The prospective donor(s) should also have completed all government requirements including quarantine, isolation and follow-up testing(s) before donation
- Member of public who had contracted COVID-19 and was symptomatic, should be deferred for 14 days after complete recovery
- Member of public who had contracted COVID-19 and was asymptomatic, should be deferred for 14 days after the date of the last positive test result
- Member of public who had close contact with a confirmed/suspected COVID-19 case, should be deferred for 14 days

**Notes about Personal Data Collection and Use:**

**Data collected in this form:** The above personal data collected from you is necessary for processing the blood donation. Such data will be used for the purposes of processing and managing matters relating to the blood donation. Voluntary helpers of the Cathedral assisting with the blood donation may have access to the above data. The above data may be shared or transferred to Hong Kong Red Cross for the purposes of the blood donation. The Cathedral will not disclose any personal data of any data subject in any way that may identify the relevant data subject, unless the disclosure is in compliance with statutory obligations, or permitted by the law. You have the right to request for a copy of your personal data maintained by the Cathedral and to correct such data. All such requests shall be made in writing and addressed to the Parish Priest of the Cathedral, and be sent to Parish Office, 16 Caine Road, Hong Kong.

**Photos and Videos:** Photos and videos may be taken at the blood donation event and these may be circulated to all participants, published in the Cathedral's official social media, or otherwise made public. By your completing and returning this form, you shall be deemed to have given your consent to the collection and use of personal data and the taking and use of photos and videos of the event which may have captured your image, as set out above.
